Regional Conference

Our LMSA Regional Conference aims to bring high school students, pre-medical undergraduates, medical students, residents, and practicing physicians together to collaboratively address and brainstorm strategies to optimally serve the needs of underserved communities. By bringing together the new ideas of younger students with the wisdom of experienced physicians, we hope to combine these insights and find practical ways to improve healthcare access for those who need it most.

The Conference serves as a forum for many key topics in healthcare, from chronic disease and medical Spanish to healthcare policy and allyship. In addition, the Conference consistently exposes attendees to workshops and panels covering strategies for success for applying to and thriving in medical school, clinical skills, and student leadership training.

Esteban López, MD, MBA

Dr. López is double board-certified in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics and is the former Chief Medical Officer and Southwest Texas President for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas. Dr. López's goal is to improve access to quality healthcare through technology and employing artificial intelligence to transform healthcare, aiming to make it more inclusive and affordable. Dr. López is a Harvard-certified expert in digital healthcare transformation, Google Cloud Healthcare contributor, and founder of Hopscotch Health, a digital platform aimed at bridging patient-provider gaps and advancing health outcomes for diverse populations.

María Fernández, PhD

Dr. Fernández, Vice President of Population Health and Implementation Science at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, is a distinguished figure in public health and medicine. As the founding Co-Director of the UTHealth Houston Institute for Implementation Science and Director of the Center for Health Promotion and Prevention Research, she specializes in participatory community-engaged research. Her work primarily focuses on cancer and chronic disease prevention among underserved populations in the U.S. and globally. Dr. Fernández has contributed extensively to this field, including over 200 peer-reviewed publications and co-authoring key books.


